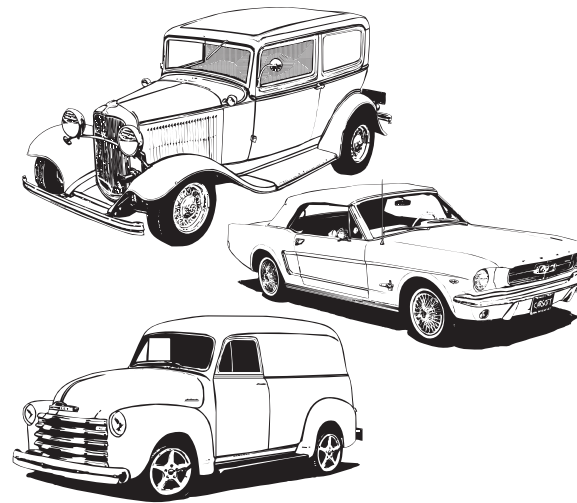


HOBBYIST'S CONCERNS

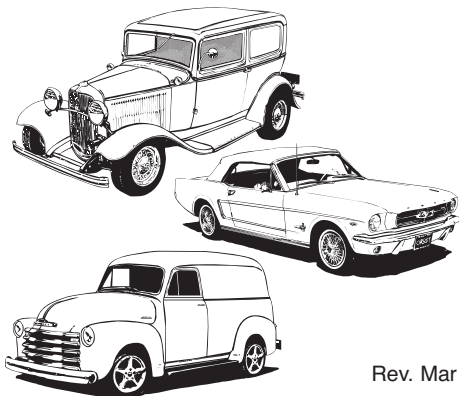

The SAACC (Saskatchewan Association of Automobile Clubs Corp.) was created by a wide range of clubs. The Association is open to all clubs with a common interest in motor vehicles. HOW DOES THE SAACC WORK?

You have the opportunity to play an active and important role in the discussion of issues affecting all of us in the hobby.

Each club sends two representatives to the SAACC general meeting, usually held three times each year.

Those representatives elect the Board of Directors. The Board acts on two fronts. It represents the membership to the governments and organizations such as Climate Change Central. The board is also responsible for monitoring legislation and making member clubs aware of possible concerns.
